



BARRICADED GUNMAN

This course will introduce and/or enhance the tactical patrol and SWAT operator's knowledge and experience in responding to and resolving barricaded subject situations. The course will focus on procedures and tactics suitable to the resolution of an armed and barricaded suspect(s) situation. Course objectives will be accomplished through classroom presentation and practical application. Topics in this course will include, but are not limited to: Defining the Barricaded gunman, the Role of Chemical Agents in Resolving incidents, legal ramifications and use of diversionary, chemical and less-lethal devices. Stealth/covert entry and movement, Dealing with Subjects in Stairwells and Attics, Covering Multiple Threats, Use of Technology, The force continuum and its applications, as well as The proper deployment of containment of patrol and entry personnel. Upon successful completion of this course, the students will have an advanced knowledge for the resolution of barricaded incidents.
