



# TACTICAL PATROL ENCOUNTERS

**TERMINAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES:** At the end of the course students understand the Proper tactics for conducting basic and high risk vehicle stops.

Further goals are to determine the differentiation between basic patrol response to basic building approach, high risk building approach, barricaded gunman, and active shooter approaches, along with the proper response to all. Students will also understand advanced techniques in weapons handling, building entry and room clearing.

**ENABLING PERFORMANCE GOAL:** through lecture and practical hands on training scenarios, instructors will evaluate students in the proper tactics for conducting single and double officer basic, high risk and felony stops. Patrol response to high risk calls and barricade situations. Patrol Response to Active shooter / Killer situations.

## PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION: ADVANCE PATROL TACTICS

### 1st 8 hour day:

How to handle the press. Negotiations
